Entry Limitations and Regulations – please read carefully

According to Chapter 1, Section 27 of the AKC Obedience Regulations, combined entries for all classes are limited to 8 hours per judge each day. Entries will be accepted in the order received, subject to the following: All regular class entries have first priority, and will be accepted up to the limits for the assigned judge. Optional titling class entries have second priority; non-regular class entries have third priority; these will be conditionally accepted as received. After closing, and processing of regular class entries, all other entries will be accepted in order of priority and date received, up to the limits for the assigned judge.

All classes will be run in **descending jump height order** beginning with the highest jump height entered in each class (except to accommodate handlers with multiple entries).

\$25.00 for the first entry of a dog in regular and optional titling classes each day

Special price for Obedience Novice A: \$10.00 each day

\$20.00 for each additional entry of the same dog in rally each day

Non-Regular Obedience Classes

\$20.00 per entry in Veterans and Wild Card Classes (Saturday and Sunday)

\$10.00 per entry in Pre-Novice (Saturday and Sunday)

\$10.00 per dog for entries in Brace, 2 dogs per brace pair (Saturday only)

\$ 5.00 per dog for entries in Team, 4 dogs per team (Saturday only)

Note: Team may enter an 5th dog as an alternate with no entry fee. Your team determines the 4 who will actually compete at the time the class begins.

Refunds will be given per AKC regulations and for entries withdrawn in writing before the closing date and time. As a courtesy to exhibitors, DOCG will give refunds for bitches that come into season after the closing date of the trial; please submit a letter of explanation from your veterinarian along with your request for such a courtesy refund.

No refunds for errors on entry forms, or if a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused. No refunds if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club.

Changes or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Entries are acknowledged via email as received. Entries are confirmed via email when all entries are processed, final judging assignments are complete, and exhibitor armband numbers are assigned.

Indicate **'UDX'** if you are entering both Open B & Utility B and you want no entry if one class or the other is already closed due to entry limitations (Obedience Regulations: Chapter 1 Section 27).

Obedience High Jump Height is required for all entries in classes with jumps in the match and trials. **Rally Jump Height** is required for Advanced and Excellent classes.

Entry Fees must be paid via Paypal for online entries. Make one payment for the combined total of all entries and pre-orders. Returned checks are not a valid payment of fees; the club will add a collection fee to any returned check.

Move-ups will be accepted per AKC regulations if the class is not full. Completed and signed move-up form must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than **30 minutes** prior to the start of judging.

Show Site will be open to exhibitors for setup from 6:00-8:30 pm Friday evening, and at 7:00 am Saturday & Sunday morning. No overnight parking in the activity center parking lot; no dogs may be left in the building overnight.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

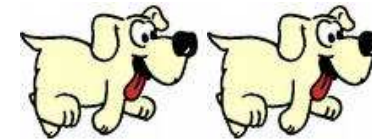
Trophies for placements in Obedience Novice A and for first place in Open A & Utility A Rosette for any new obedience or rally title earned at our show.

DOCG is pleased to offer an OC Match with ring time for "run-thrus" in the Novice, Open, and Utility rings. Each handler may select class exercises to be performed within a block of time. 5 minutes for Novice and Open rings (plus group sits & downs); 10 minutes for Utility ring.

There are no prizes, ribbons, scoring or placements for the Match.

Verbal corrections and gentle guidance will be permitted.

No food or toys will be permitted in the rings.

Group sits and downs are included at no additional charge for dogs signed up for Match Novice or Open ring time. Group exercises will be conducted at appropriate intervals at the club's discretion.

Match Ring Time entries will be accepted only in advance, and only for dogs that are entered in our trials on Saturday or Sunday (any class). Match entries will be accepted in the order received up to match ring time limits.

High Jump Height is required for all classes. Dogs will be assigned ring time by armband number. Match will be run in **descending jump height order** beginning with the highest entered in each class (except to accommodate handlers with multiple entries).

To enter, specify ring(s) (Novice, Open, Utility) on your entry form, and submit payment with your trial entry. You may enter online.

Match Fee will be refunded if the match ring is full. Enter early - the match is very popular. DOCG club members will conduct the match and members will do their own ring time separately before the match begins.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
